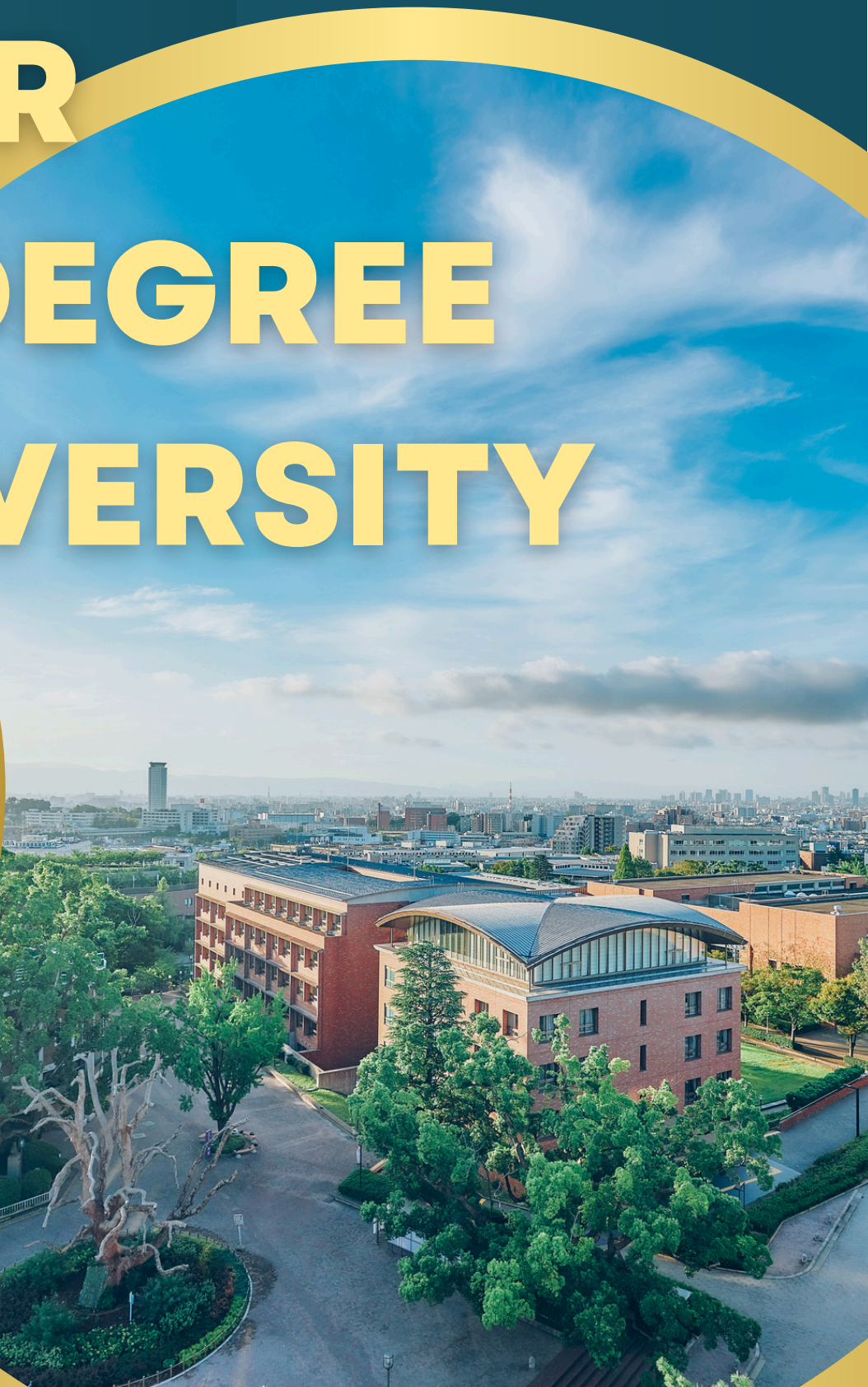
SCHOLARSHIP 2026

The MEXT University Recommendation Scholarship is a prestigious, fully-funded scholarship sponsored by the Japanese government. To be considered for this scholarship through Kansai University, applicants must first apply for admission using the steps outlined below. Those who successfully pass the admissions process will be recommended for the scholarship. Please note that as the number of recommendation slots is limited, only a select few applicants will receive a Letter of Acceptance through this admission procedure.

Qualifications:

- Have the nationality of a country that has diplomatic relations with the Japanese government. Applicants with Japanese nationality are not eligible.
- Have been born on or after April 2, 1991.
- Be in good physical and mental health.
- Be willing to newly acquire a student visa and newly enter Japan for the purpose of study upon receiving the scholarship.
- Be able to arrive in Japan in mid-September 2026.
- Have a CGPA of 2.30 or higher out of 3.00, calculated according to MEXT's formula, for the current degree program.
- For applicants to English-medium degree programs: Have English proficiency equivalent to CEFR B2 or higher, or have completed (or be currently completing) the most recent degree program in English.

How to Apply:

1. Obtain approval from your future/supervising professor.
2. Complete the required application form.
3. Submit the application by January 20th, 2026.
4. Organize an online meeting or discuss a detailed research plan with your supervisor.

✦ Please choose the professor you wish to study under carefully, as you generally cannot change your advisor after entering our university. Please refrain from contacting multiple professors at the same time, as this may cause confusion. When you email one of our professors, please include your full information so that the professor can clearly understand your background and the purpose of your inquiry.

Application Documents

1. Application Form (with photograph attached) [Form 6]
2. Major and Research Plan [Form 7] *Applicants are required to obtain prior approval of their research plan from their prospective academic supervisor.
3. Motivation Letter [Form 8]
4. Documents verifying the applicant's nationality and legal status (e.g., a copy of a passport, a family register issued by the home country, or a certificate of citizenship)
5. Official academic transcript from the applicant's most recent university (undergraduate or graduate level), issued by the institution
6. Graduation certificate, expected graduation certificate, or degree certificate from the applicant's most recent university (undergraduate or graduate level)
7. Academic transcript or official document demonstrating outstanding academic performance at the most recent university
8. Letter of recommendation from the head of the graduate school, department, or equivalent authority at the applicant's current institution (addressed to the President of Kansai University)
9. Thesis or paper summary (a concise overview of the research content)
10. Documents demonstrating fulfillment of the language proficiency requirements specified in the application guidelines (e.g., TOEFL, IELTS, or JLPT certificates). *This requirement is waived for native English speakers.
